Forest ecosystem services, forest transition and forest restoration: Linkages, overlaps and opportunities for integration

Ecosystem services (ES), forest transition (FT) and forest restoration (FR) are three conceptual approaches to understanding the interactions between societies and forests. They each represent empirical processes, forestry theoretical debates and two of them are part of the global environmental governance regime. ES, FT and FR are interlinked, but the linkages between the three concepts are until today insufficiently understood, or explored. Nor is the value and relevance of these linkages recognized for policy opportunities, public administration and management interventions. The lecture will provide brief introductions to ES, FT and FR, identify overlaps and linkages and reflect on implications for research and forestry practice.
